

Unitary Surfacing

Unitary surfacing offers the greatest level of customization and impact protection and is the most wheelchair friendly option for your playground. Unitary surfaces are cured after installment to form a shock-absorbing surface and are available in different thicknesses for various fall heights. ***All unitary surfaces must be installed over a subbase of crushed stone, asphalt or concrete. Installation prices differ.**



ARTIFICIAL TURF

\$12 - \$18 PER SQ FT INSTALLED

AVG TOTAL (1000 SQ FT):
\$12,000 - \$18,000

Visually striking, two-layered, extremely porous system, allowing for a free flow of water to reduce flooding. This combination of fibers gives the turf a soft, carpet-like feel.

Pros

- Completely anti-microbial
- Mold and mildew resistant
- Dries quickly, resume play almost immediately after rain
- Quick dry properties remain for the life of the product
- Pesticide-free
- Up to 10-Year Warranty

Cons

- Can wear down in high traffic areas (slide bases & swing sets).
- Can become hotter in sunlight than other surfaces
- When not properly maintained, can create dust/pollen build-up



POURED-IN-PLACE

The most popular unitary surfacing on the market, is a recycled, porous, two-layered seamless and resilient playground surface that offers virtually limitless graphic possibilities.

Pros

- Earth-friendly
- Can be customized with logos or designs of your choice
- Warranties vary depending on the product
- Qualifies for LEED credits/grants
- Can easily change surface depth as needed

Cons

- Can wear down in high traffic areas (slide bases & swing sets).
- Discoloration can occur when installed in improper conditions.
- Required top coat maintenance to reduce color fading from sun



RUBBER TILES

\$14 - \$22 PER SQ FT INSTALLED

AVG TOTAL (1000 SQ FT):
\$14,000 - \$22,000

Typically 2 X 2 ft. with varying thicknesses for fall heights up to 10 ft. Unique, interlocking design allows for easy installation while preventing curling or separating between tiles.

Pros

- Combine colors to create custom designs
- Earth-friendly
- Easily replace damaged tiles
- 10-Year Warranty on materials and workmanship, including impact attenuation
- Virtually maintenance free

Cons

- Limited color options
- Strict installation requirements
- Edges can curl over time
- Has an initial, pronounced odor
- Seams can loosen over time
